The "Dr. Joseph Warren, George C. & Teri Wildrick Scholarship" was established by the Doctor Joseph Warren Foundation (DJWF) to help honor the legacy of George C. Wildrick. Mr. Wildrick was the fifth-great grandson of Dr. Joseph Warren, a physician and hero of the Revolutionary War who was killed at the Battle of Bunker Hill in Charlestown in 1775.

Mr. Wildrick was a West Point graduate who served his country with honor, following in the footsteps of generations of Dr. Joseph Warren descendants. A core belief championed and supported by Mr. and Mrs. Wildrick is that every student should have access to higher education.

We are pleased to offer a scholarship in the amount of \$500.00 for one (1) high school senior of Lake George Junior / Senior High School. The scholarship is non-renewable. The applications will be evaluated on the below criteria.

#### Criteria

- The student must submit an essay, not less than 500 words and not more than 700 words, or a short video answering the attached question.
- The student must be a high school senior attending **Warren County Public Schools** & have at least a 2.5 GPA.
- The applicant must be an entering freshman to an accredited college or university.
