This communication is a reminder that scholarship grant applications for this year are now being accepted at this office through April 1, 2025. The grants will be for \$3000 each, and may be used for tuition, fees, room and board or other necessary direct college expense.

All applications received by the deadline date will be logged by The Foundation and referred to the Selection Committee (independent of The Foundation) for their evaluation and selection process. This process shall be rendered on an objective and non-discriminatory basis in keeping with the procedures established for this program.

Announcement of the awards will be mailed from The Foundation office to the individual applicants on or about May 15th.

2025 represents the 46th year this program has been offered. In 2024, The Sandy Hill Foundation granted 50 awards.

Attached are ten application forms with an outline of the program procedures and requirements. Additional application forms may be duplicated by you or will be supplied upon request.

### Scholarship Program

The Sandy Hill Foundation of Hudson Falls, New York offers scholarship grants for college education on an annual basis to assist qualifying young women and men graduating from designated local area schools. In 2024, The Foundation Trustees awarded 50 grants. The awards this year will be for \$3000 each.

These scholarship grants are restricted to tuition, fees, books, supplies, room and board or other necessary direct college expense. The Internal Revenue Service has mandated that The Sandy Hill Foundation remit these payments directly to the educational institution for credit to the student's account.

All applications received in The Foundation office by the due date will be referred to a Selection Committee independent of The Foundation for evaluation and rating. Grants will be awarded on academic performance and achievements, standard educational tests, financial need and letters of recommendation received relating to the character, motivation and potential of the individual.

Applicants <u>must request</u> the Guidance Department to provide a copy of their current school academic record, including but not limited to, academic achievement, standardized test results, and letter(s) of recommendation. This may be mailed under separate cover.

In addition, each applicant is required to <u>attach</u> a written statement indicating their academic and occupational career goals, individual interests and activities while attending secondary school plus any other information deemed pertinent to support the student's application for evaluation by the Selection Committee. All personal summaries and data must be typed or printed. Also required is a copy of Page 1 (ONLY) of the applicant's parent's Federal Tax Return Form 1040 which can be mailed separately or submitted in sealed envelope with application. NOTE:- Social Security numbers are <u>NOT</u> needed on the tax return.

Failure to furnish the requested documentation with the application will void its eligibility.
